Dear friends,

The Titus County Republican Party took a giant leap forward in 2010, and we want to keep growing. No one can deny the unrest in the country, coupled with the enthusiasm of the local TEA Party, contributed greatly to the voters being energized to get to the polls last year. It has been especially exciting for me to see all that movement in the conservative grassroots.

There was a lot happening in the local Republican Party too. I am fortunate to have a very dedicated Executive Committee to work with, and we did a lot of "First's" last year to make the Party more visible in the county. I just want to give you a quick look at where we've been and what was accomplished in 2010.

- Candidate Recruitment started early in the fall of 2009. That was the first time our party actually had a search committee out looking for good candidates. We had a very productive several months leading up to the January filing date. That process will start up again this coming Fall. You might want to be part of the committee.
- We held a Primary Election in March 2010 - This was the first time in Titus history that the Republican Party had a contest on our side of the ticket in a Primary race. Two Republican candidates ran for Commissioner Precinct 4, and three candidates ran for Justice of the Peace - Precinct 2. In addition we had a candidate run for County Judge and District Court Judge, both unopposed. That translated into **the largest Primary turn-out for the Republican ticket ever**.
 - In 2006 we had only 373 voters, in the gubernatorial year.
 - In 2010 there were 1482 voters! Folks that's **nearly a 400% increase!**
 - We had to have a Runoff election for Justice of the Peace, Precinct 2. No one thought that would happen in the Titus Republican Party.
- In July we had a very successful fund-raiser Bar-B-Que at Priefert's Barn for our candidates. It was great fun with the candidates bringing cakes and pies that were auctioned off for their campaigns.
- In September we opened our Election Headquarters on 1st Street for the General Election. From the HQ we did several educational events.
 - Workshop about Voter Fraud
 - Poll Watchers Training
 - Candidate Debate Preparation
 - Erwin Cain phone call training

- Our booth at the Titus County Fair had to be doubled to accommodate all of our candidates, that was a first!
- The November Election was a mix of victory and defeat. Deni Goebel and Jimmy Parker came in so close in their races. The percentages they received have never been seen before in our
- county. It just **proves that the future looks very bright for conservative Republican candidates in Titus County**. The celebration that night was for Brian Lee, who won the County Judge seat. The first Republican County Judge in Titus history. I think **that race was most significant for our county!** The entrenched Democrat Party is losing control, even with all the trickery and scheming they do.
- The control of voting precincts is determined in the Governor's race every 4 years. Whichever party wins the precinct, that party gets to appoint the Presiding Judge for all the elections in the next 4 years.
 - Prior to the General Election, Republicans were in control of 10 of the 19 county voting precincts/boxes.
 - As of November 2, 2010, **Republicans now control 15 out of 19 voting precincts/boxes in Titus County!** New voting Precincts who have gone Republican are: Talco, Argo, Winfield, West New Hope and the Courthouse Annex.

This past year has also been an eye opening experience into how elections are run in Titus County.

The Titus County Republican Party has spent over \$400 out of our tiny budget, getting copies of records to piece some of the accusations of fraud together. **We have not stopped!** We have documented evidence that shows there is much that is not right in our election process, and we will present it to the authorities in the very near future. We want fair and legal elections in Titus County, and we intend to pursue the investigation to its conclusion.

The next two years will be critical for party growth and fund raising. The national and state elections get lots of attention, but we have some important local races coming up too. We will need to set up a Headquarters again for both the Primary and General elections in 2012, help our candidates, and buy road/yard signs for the Presidential campaign. No, those signs are not just given to us...we buy them!

We get **no money from the State party or National party**. None of those surveys or pledge forms you see in the mail are for us! We count completely on your generous support.
